OUR 5 FOCUS POINTS

Encounter: Encountering God is the foundation on which all else stands. There will be space for devotion to get closer to God and learn how to hear His voice.

Establish: You will receive in depth Bible teaching, and learn ways to enhance your studies to help further establish your faith.

Equip: We will teach and train you in areas such as evangelism (sharing your faith), apologetics (defending the faith) and pastoral care so you're equipped for works of service.

MISSION TRIP

As part of the programme we will organise a mission trip to another Church in a different country to go and serve them and their community. This will be a great opportunity to learn about God, Christianity and Church life in a different culture and for you to grow as a person.









The trip will be optional and incur an additional cost. We will endeavour to keep this as low as possible.



FUNDING

FUNDRAISING

Whilst your cost is only £1200 the programme will cost considerably more than that per student to run. As we wanted to keep your costs as affordable as possible, we decided to utilise other means of financial support to ensure students can get the best possible input at the lowest possible price. One of those means will be through fundraising activities and events that we hold at different intervals of the programme



SPONSORSHIP

As well as fundraising we are asking the wider Church to get involved by sponsoring the programme. A monthly donation from 3 people of just £10 a month would help towards the additional costs of 1 student. Whether it be a one off gift or recurring donations, all will be greatly appreciated and really helpful.

SCHOLARSHIP

We are aware that for some people £1200 will still be too much of a stretch. That is why we will be looking for people who are willing to provide a scholarship by paying some or all of the £1200 fee for a student.

Criteria

- Age: 18 years and over
- Be a believer and agree with our statement of faith
- Be a church attender for the duration of the programme

Application Process

- Final application date: 31st
 January '25
- Interviews: March '25
- Offer of placement: 10th April '25
- Accept the offer: 31st May '25

FAQ

- 1. **Do you offer payment structures?** A) Yes, you can pay monthly, termly, or a lump sum.
- 2. Will there be other costs?

 A) There will be an optional extra for those wanting to do the mission trip and some small costs towards books if you want to own them.
- 3. What equipment do I need?

 A) You will need a Bible,
 notebook and pen.
